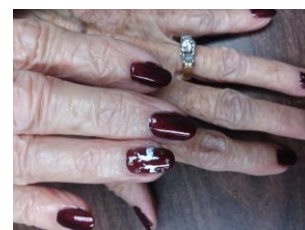
Dover Library – Passport to...
